Behaviour - our new rules

We discussed rules and how we can improve attitudes to behaviour across school. The children really wanted simple rules that were easy for everyone to remember and to understand. Staff were also consulted, and between us we agreed on the following rules:-

Children are being taught in class and during assemblies about the importance of following these rules to support our school community.
